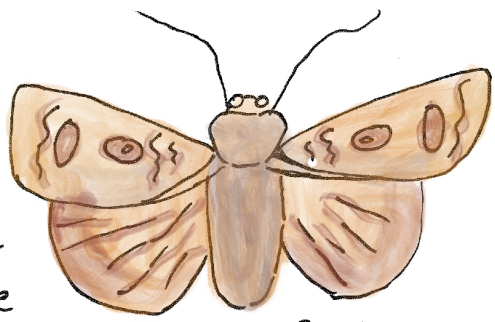
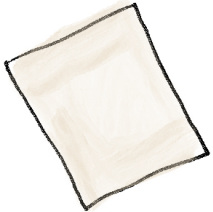


Bogong Moth

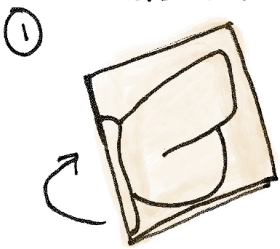


Bogong moths migrate from their winter breeding grounds throughout Queensland, NSW and Victoria, to the Victorian Alpine region, where they are the main food source for the Mountain Pygmy Possum. We can help the mountain Pygmy Possum by turning off our lights at night to assist the Bogong Moth Migration.

YOU NEED:



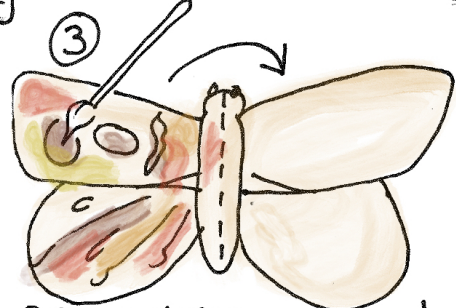
Recycled paper - scissors - tape - string - stick - Paint + brush



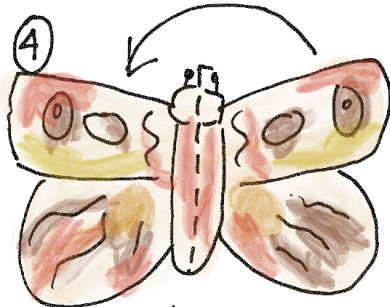
fold paper/card in half draw half a moth on



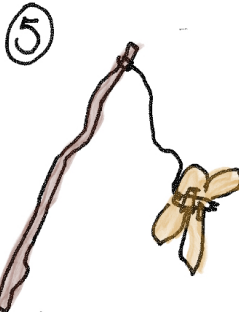
cut out



Paint patterns on one side, blobs, squiggles, lines, get creative



Fold Moth in half press down, then open back up, then see the symmetry



Stick your moth to string and tie string to a stick



Take your moth out to explore, can it fly on a Migration through your garden? Remember to switch off lights to help it!
