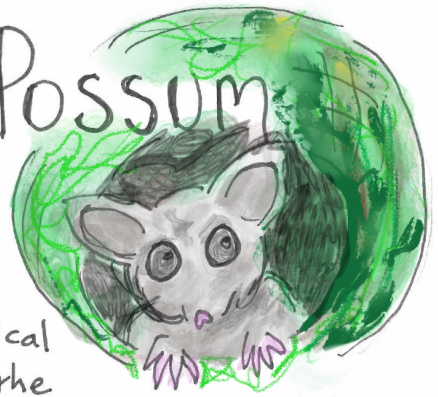


# Mountain Pygmy Possum

## Nest cubby

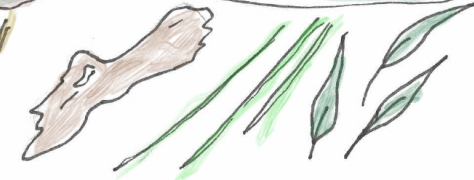


Mountain Pygmy Possum build spherical nests out of moss in amongst the boulder fields. They eat Bogong Moths and will hibernate in their nests through the snowy winter. These possums are critically endangered.

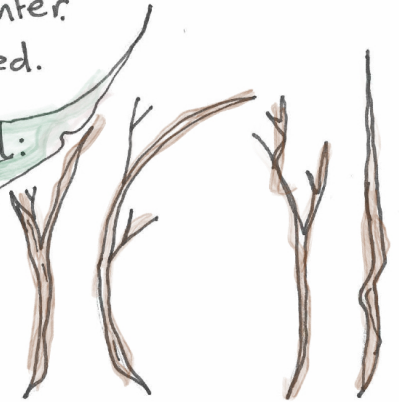
To make your nest you need:



String or Rope  
Take this home after, don't leave in Nature.



Weaving materials: bark grasses, leaves.



Strong long branches



### Step 1

Tie your branches together at the top making a strong frame leave a door for your nest cubby.



### Step 2

Cover with leaves, bark, grasses and any materials you find on the ground. Weave in and out of the branches.



### Step 3

Imagine you are a Mountain Pygmy Possum Crawl inside your cubby nest. Close your eyes like you are hibernating what sounds in nature can you hear?
